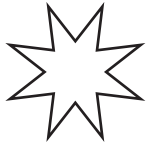
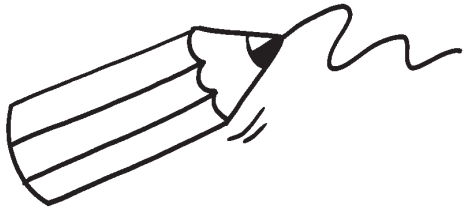
Step 1

Photocopy onto card (if you want to use strong card, simply photocopy onto paper (A4) then fix to card using spray adhesive in a well ventilated room).



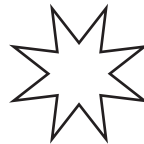
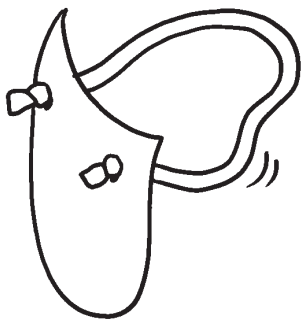
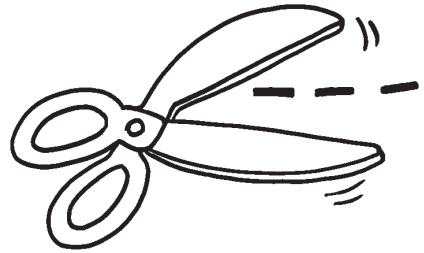
Step 2

Decorate the mask with crayons, felt tips, paint, sequins, buttons, shiny or unusual textured paper or material.



Step 3

Cut along the dotted lines and punch holes where the black dots are.



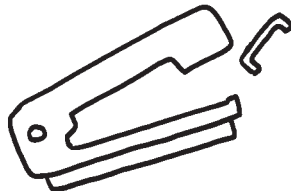
Step 4

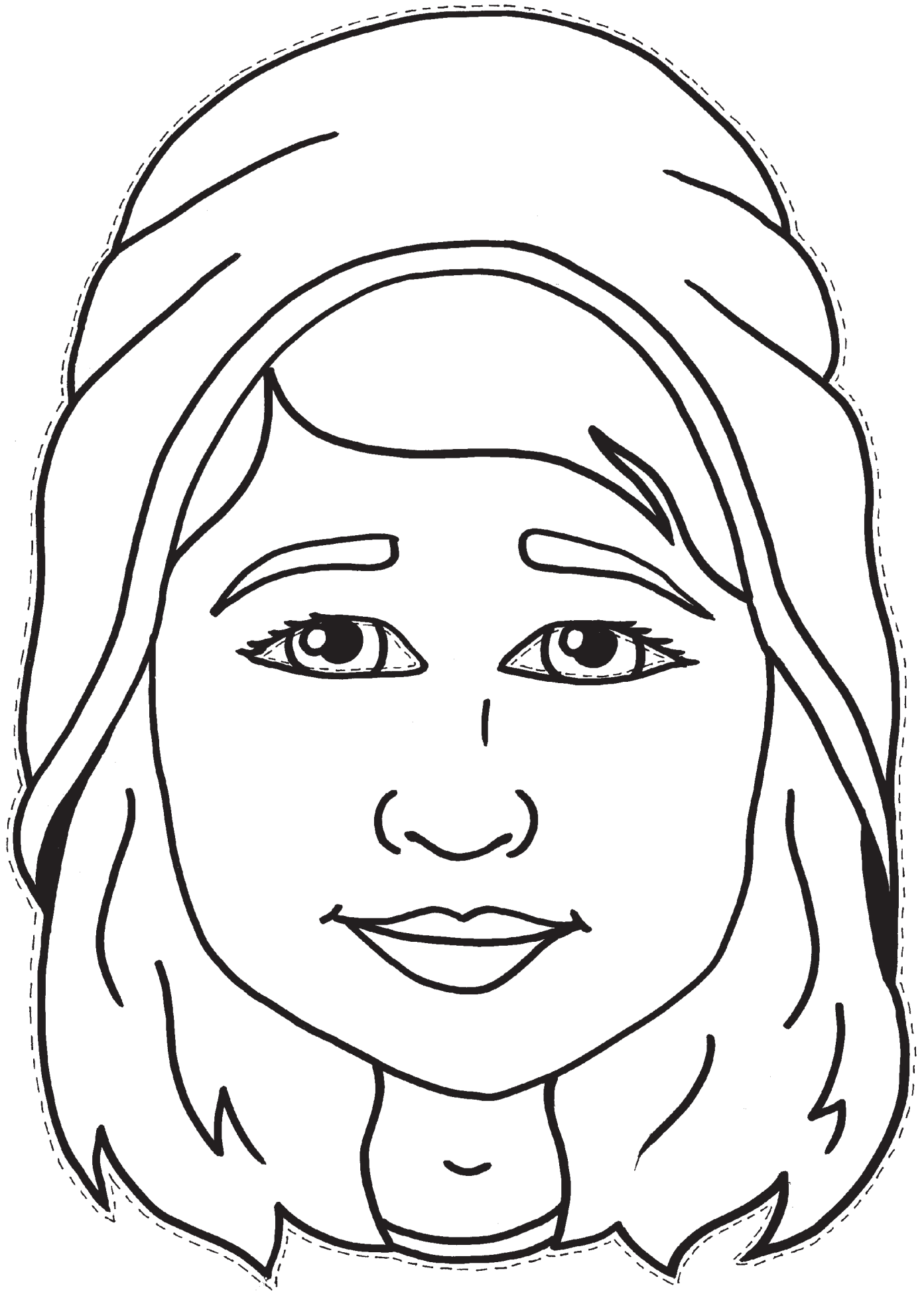
Secure elasticated string through the holes. You will need approx 60 cms per mask.

For large ears follow the same steps then simply staple, glue or use double sided tape to secure to the animals head.

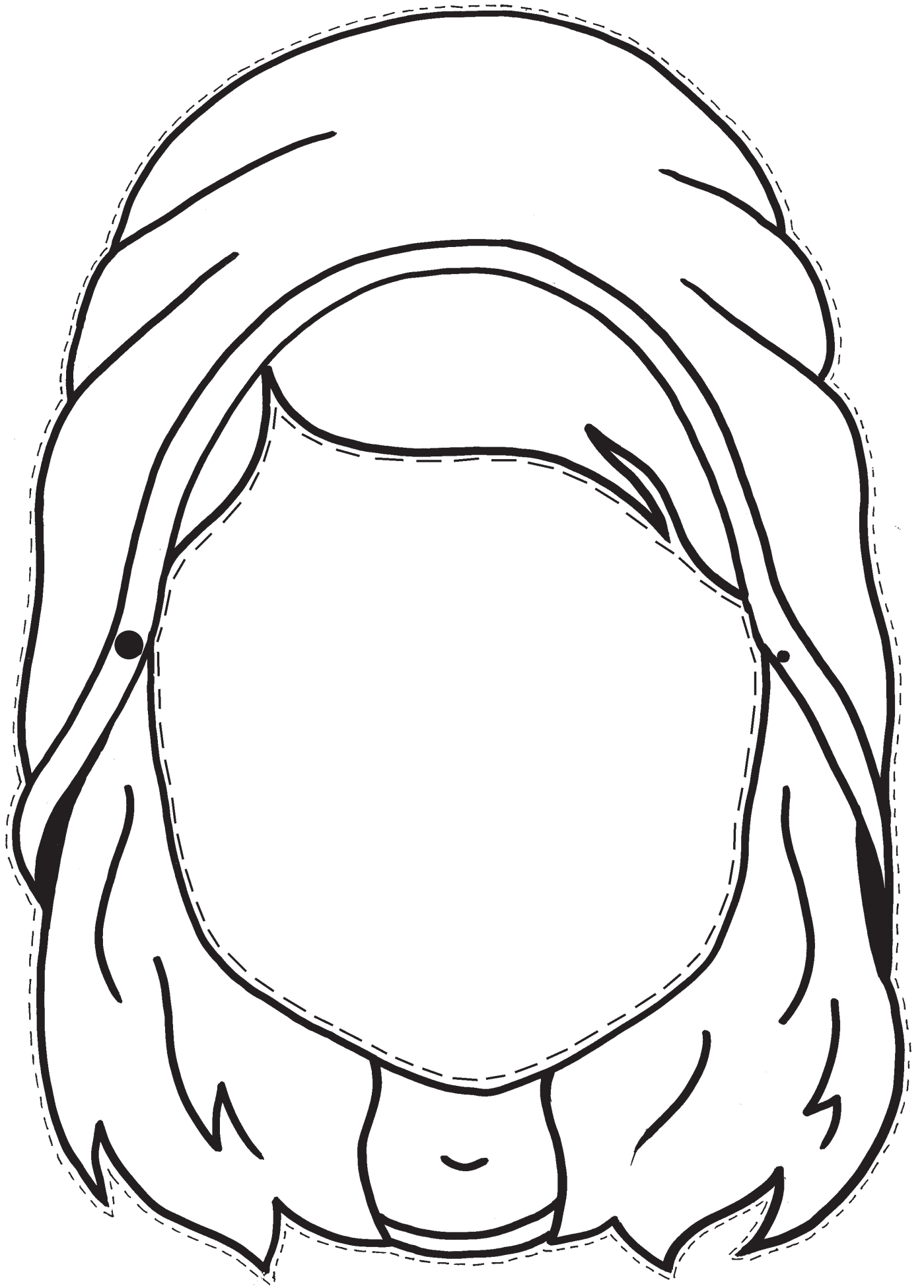


As an option, you could secure strong card, tubing or dowling to the back of the mask.
